## FRIENDS of the ROSSLAND RANGE

## **CONSTITUTION**

- 1. The name of the society is Friends of the Rossland Range.
- 2. The purposes of the society are:
  - (a) To educate people within our region about the economic and health benefits of retaining natural areas with their ecosystems intact;
  - (b) To advocate for non-motorized recreational use (both public and commercial) and protection of the natural attributes and wildlife of the Rossland Range and the surrounding region;
  - (c) To influence land use policy in this area for the benefit of the community;
  - (d) To carry on any activity that advances the purposes stated above.
- 3. On dissolution of the Society, and after paying the Society's debts, the members must distribute the Society's remaining assets to one or more charitable organizations incorporated in British Columbia with similar purposes, pursuant to the regulations of the Income Tax Act.
- 4. The Society must be operated as a charitable organization without financial gain for its members, and all earnings and donations must be used only for promoting the Society's purposes.
- 5. Clauses 3, 4 and 5 are unalterable.
