 - the Rec Site is "USE AT YOUR OWN RISK". So come prepared and use within your limits
 - candles are not permitted in any Cabin - use LED lights
 - use firewood with discretion - NO outdoor fires
 - plowing of the 5 parking lots is done when the contractor is available - often a few days after a big snowfall
 - Use judgement when using lots if not plowed - even 4x4s get stuck.
 - This plowing is FORR'S greatest expense
