CABINS ACCESS - GIVEN COVID PANDEMIC CONTINUING: Cabin status continuing: "Closed - Except for Emergency Use" We are seeking clarity, and any means of opening the cabins. Unfortunately, enabling public access is a challenge due to the small, tight spaces with uncertain ventilation and being entirely unmanaged situations. Very frustrating given the efforts and cost to build the cabins and the high demand for their use.

REC SITE 2021 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Rec Site has been heavily used (other than cabins) as people seek outdoor activities.
- The hike to Old Glory has had a huge increase in numbers.
- New Crowe's Nest Cabin foundation complete on site and prefab structure stored in town, Heli-lift and assembly next summer. Old Crowe's Nest Shelter is still in service this winter (subject to Covid rule).
- New Kiosk with interpretive info panels (Lookout-Gibbard & Met Station) at Old Glory Trailhead beside Hwy 3B.
- Parking Lot expanded at "Camera" serving Elgood area, Igloo Cabin and 100 Acre Wood.
- Accessible Trail benches installed.
- FoRRS request to Highways for transfer of Pit to recreation purpose once Pit to be abandoned by Highways.
